

REGULATIONS

The regulations and by-laws of the Royal Agricultural Society shall apply to this show, except where otherwise stated.

1. Every exhibit, except livestock, must be grown by or be the work of the exhibitor (unless otherwise stated) and any exhibitor may be called upon to make an affidavit to that effect. All livestock must be the property of the exhibitor.
2. ENTRY FEES: Fees as published in this schedule must be prepaid and accompanied by the Society's printed entry form. No entry form will be received without the entry fee and the Society's printed entry form.
3. All exhibits in Cattle Sections must be on the Show ground not later than 9.00am and to remain until 2.30pm, except by consent of the stewards. Stewards will be in attendance from 7.30am onwards to receive exhibits.
Only ribbons won at the 2019 Show to be worn.
All entries are received subject to these show regulations and by-laws, the special regulations in each section are to be uniform by-laws made under the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1926.
4. The committee may at any time disqualify from exhibiting either indefinitely or for any period it may think fit any exhibitor who has in the opinion of the committee been guilty of any breach of these regulations, or whose conduct whether at or during any show of the Society has in the opinion of the committee been such that he or she is unfit to exhibit at any show of the Society.
5. No person who has been disqualified from exhibiting at any show of the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia Incorporated, or at any show of any society affiliated there with, shall during the period of disqualification be allowed to act as agent, representative or servant of any exhibitor at any show of the Society.
6. Livestock which has been exhibited at any unregistered show shall be disqualified from competing at any show of the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia Incorporated, or by any Society affiliated therewith and should any entry be accidentally accepted it shall be deemed to be void and the entry fee will be returned.
7. The Judges may withhold prizes for such exhibits as they deem unworthy.
8. PROTESTS: All protests must be in writing and lodged with the Chief Stewards, accompanied by a \$20.00 fee, within 5 minutes of the decision being protested against. Stewards to be made aware of the fact at the time. All appeals to be heard and decided on the day of the show.
9. Exhibits must not be removed before 5.30pm on Saturday 30th April except with permission by the Section Steward. Stewards will not be responsible for perishables after this time. Alternatively, Hall exhibits may be collected Sunday 1st May 2022 between 9.30-10.30am.
10. Poultry must be shown in coops provided by the Society.
11. Space will be provided for sideshows and Applications for space is to be made to the Show Coordinator.
12. Space in the showgrounds will be provided for the display of Agricultural Machinery and Implements and for the display of anything of use to the farmer or fruit grower.
