### Important Notes:

- NO frames or glass.
- Please attach a minimum of 4 Velcro circles to large photographs and a minimum of 2 Velcro circles to small photographs.
- Please put your name and class on the back of photographs the right way up.
- MAXIMUM OF 3 PHOTOGRAPHS PER CLASS PER PERSON.
- Photographs can be printed by a commercial printer or home printer but the Exhibit (must conform to size requirements for each Class)
- All Entries are to have been taken by the Exhibitor.
- No previous **HARVEY SHOW** Prize Winning Photographs are eligible.
- No person is to remove Photographs from the display without permission from one of the Photography Stewards.
- Photographs will be packed up by the Stewards and distributed from 4.30pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

### Helpful Hints and Tips:

- A Portrait is a photograph of a person who is posing for the camera.
- Animal Photograph The pet should fill as much of the picture frame as possible. Check your background for anything that will distract the viewer (and the judge) away from your subject.
- Landscape or Seascape the scene that attracted you has to dominate the picture in order to interest others. Exclude all distractions. If photographing the horizon in a seascape, make sure it is level.
- Sunrise or Sunset Pointing a camera at the sky to photograph means that everything else on the ground will be a dark shadow. Minimize the dark area as much as possible but include interesting silhouettes that will add to the interest of the picture.
- Open Subject This Class is for any subject not covered by the rest of the program. All Entries will be judged on impact as they have to compete against different subject matters.
- Artistic Photographs may be digitally enhanced for this Class using a computer program. Artistic creativity, imagination and impact are important for this Class.
- Selfie Photo Same rules apply as per portrait photo of family scene. Making sure your subject or subjects are in focus and within the picture.

## Points that will penalize your Photograph:

- Size Requirements: Ensure your photograph is the correct size for the Class you are entering. Too big or too small will be penalized, even if it is a better photograph
- Tilted horizons
- Out of focus or blurred
- Cluttered or messy backgrounds distracting from the subject
- Writing or date on the front of photographs
- Not displayed properly on stiff card
- Make sure the photograph is in the correct class
- Part of the subject chopped off (feet, arm, head)
- Subject not filling the frame (especially portraits)
